Art Technique -

Wet-on wet, or *alla prima* (Italian, meaning at first attempt), a painting technique in which layers of wet paint are applied to previously administered layers of wet paint. Used mostly in oil painting, the technique requires a fast way of working, because the work has to be finished before the first layers have dried.

Artist of the Month

Dawn Marple

Born in Venice, California, I was surrounded by art. My Mom is a fine arts artist, so I have had a paintbrush in my hand as long as I can remember. As hard as I tried, fine art was not something I ever had the patience for. It was incredibly frustrating for me. My Mom introduced me to abstract art and I was hooked. But I never shared my art outside of my immediate family. It was my "secret".

My father passed away 15 years ago and my passion for art and creating passed with him. In December of 2020, with the stress of trying to keep 40 essential employees safe from Covid, my body fired a warning shot and I had a very small stroke. It left me mostly blind in my right eye. I was incredibly lucky. It could have been so much worse.

All of the doctors told me I needed to find a way to reduce the stress or this would happen again and it would be worse. I remembered seeing an artist in Santa Barbara that was getting the most incredible reactions using fluid paint. I spent months learning techniques, experimenting with mixing recipes for different reactions in paint. It wasn't long before I was making a mess and painting again. In May of 2021 I shared my very first piece with "the world". I posted a piece on Facebook. To my surprise, I received several requests to purchase the piece. It was exciting and so validating. Within weeks I had requests to buy more and was even commissioned to create custom work for people's homes.

In January of 2023, I walked away from over 30 years in operations management in corporate America. My health was more important than working 70 hours a week. Now I do several art shows a year, I teach fluid art, and I am commissioned regularly to create pieces for my clients. Recently I was approached to help bring art and culture back to downtown Oxnard. My first showing is in early April at an art crawl. I even had a piece hung in the Pro-Arts building for the Ventura County Fair. Far more exciting than I could ever have imagined.

With the support of my husband, family and dear friends, I am now fully absorbed in my art. No looking back. I couldn't be happier! Art, quite literally, saved my life.
